



## Update To Visitor's Guidelines Effective August 24, 2020

- **All admitted Inpatients** will be allowed a maximum of 2 visitors per day (1 at a time) between the hours of 13:00-20:00 pm. All visitors must sign in and be screened at the designated screening area and must wear a mask the entire time while visiting.
- **Medical and Spiritual care (Clergy, Hospice Volunteers, medical- Foot care)**—can visit 1 patient/day (they do not count as a visitor)—visits must occur between 8 am - 13:00 pm —this does not include hair dressers, esthetician etc. They must sign in and be screened at the designated screening area and must wear a mask the entire time while visiting.
- **Patients who require support (this includes outpatients, ER and ambulatory care, Obstetrical Ultrasound):** A small number of patients (e.g. very frail/elderly, patient with dementia, person who is non-verbal or severely disabled, Paediatric or those in critical condition) are allowed 1 support person or advocate to be present.
- **No Visitors** for patients in isolation for COVID ONLY (pending or confirmed)
