POSITION SUMMARY:

Responsible for providing system navigation, supportive counselling, and short term case management in an outpatient/ambulatory care setting to patients with mental health concerns within the assessment and treatment framework of social work knowledge and skills.

- Minimum 3 years previous related experience

- > Understand and adhere to the PHIPA, Code of Ethics and Standards of the Practice of Social Work
- > Strong administration skills, including documentation, statistical records, use of electronic medical records (CERNER preferred)
- > Strong case management skills, including identifying and coordinating programs and supports for outpatients, with brief follow up as needed
- Ability to apply multiple theories and interventions with patients, including brief-solution focused

POSITION-SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASKS:

- *Intake and Assessment*—gather information using an evidence-based psychosocial assessment to identify current and future needs, goals and level of risk for patients.
- System navigation —Assist patients in navigating health and social service systems by providing resources for health, employment, legal, income, housing addictions and mental health supports
- *Case management* –coordinate services, programs and supports that address the needs identified by the patient and provide follow up to ensure appropriate fit of the referrals
- *Advocacy* –Advocate on behalf of patients with agencies and systems, while increasing patient's self-advocacy skills, ensuring safe transitions to patient supports
- Supportive Counselling –brief solution focused and cognitive behavioural therapy as well as crisis intervention on a short term basis
- *Community Engagement*—liaise with community providers to support patient transitions to community programs, supports and counselling
